Context

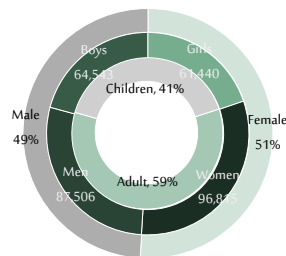
In this report, we highlighted some of the project activities carried out by SHAML members which covered the first three months of 2018 for relief projects and non-relief projects activities. The data were collected from seven organizations formed SHAML Coalition: Basmeh & Zeitooneh, Emissa, Kesh Malek, Local Development and Small Projects Support office (LDSPS), Olive Branch, Space of Hope and Women Now for Development. The report covers 7 Governorates of Syria, 18 Districts, 30 Sub-districts and 62 Communities. The activities contains three Relief clusters: WASH, Education, Early Recovery and Protection, and five Non-relief clusters: Access-Coordination, Social Cohesion, Community Resilience, Human Rights, Women Empowerment. Beneficiaries distributed over 158,255 (51%) females including 61,440 girls and 96,815 women and 152,049 (49%) males including 64,543 boys, 87,506 men.

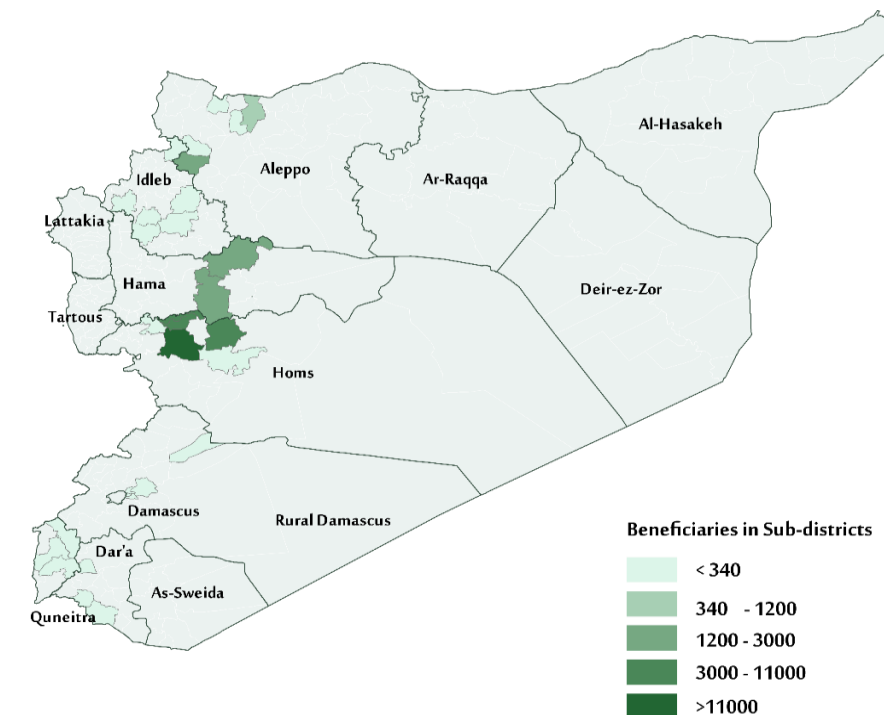

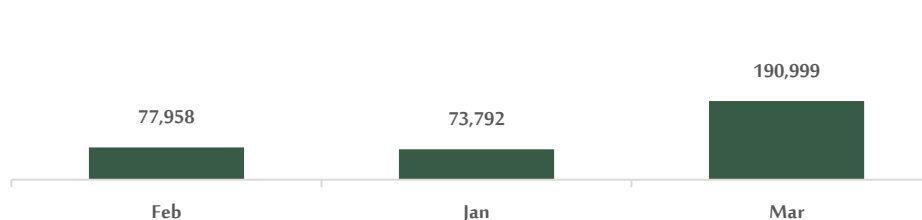
